Vacancy :Praying about the next step

Our call to Rev Calum MacMillan, with a note of our reasons , has been sent to the Northern Presbytery, who will consider it on 26th March. At that meeting a delegation from Kilmallie and Ardnamurchan will be invited to state why we want to call Calum, and the Rosskeen Kirk Session will be invited to say why they want to keep him. Normally the Presbytery would then place the call in Calum's hands and invite him to respond.

It would be surprising , but possible, for the Presbytery not to put the call in Calum's hands on the grounds that his leaving Rosskeen would be seriously detrimental, if that step were taken we have the right of appeal.
